

Alango SonicVibrance[™] package installation guide

 Winamp DSP/Effect Plug-ins are stored in Winamp's plug-ins directory. Usually it is C:\Program Files\Winamp\Plugins; the exact location can be retrieved by accessing the Options > Preferences menu.



Preferences menu can also be opened directly with hotkey Ctrl+P

- 2. To install the plug-in simply save/extract it to the Plugins directory (may require restarting Winamp if opened). Do not rename the dll file! (dsp_ prefix is essential).
- 3. As soon as the Plug-in is present in the Plugins directory, it will appear in the DSP/Effect tab of Winamp Preferences window. No further installation or configuration is needed in V1.0.
